Head Constable \{Assistant Wireless Operator [(AWO)/Tele-Printer Operator (TPO)] in Delhi Police Examination, 2022-Declaration of final result

The Staff Selection Commission declared the result of the Computer Based Examination on 30.12.2022 wherein 16042 unique candidates were short-listed to appear in Physical Endurance and Measurement Test (PE\&MT) and Trade Test. PE\&MT and DV was conducted by Delhi Police from 28.03.2023 to 13.04.2023.
2. The summary of the result of PE\&MT and Document Verification is as under:-
